## **BOARD OFFICERS**

The President, Vice-President and Clerk of the Board of Education shall be elected by members of the Board at the annual reorganization meeting in July.

## Duties of the President of the Board

The duties of the President of the Board shall be as follows:

- 1. to preside at all meetings;
- 2. to call special meetings he/she considers necessary or on request of one member of the Board;
- 3. to appoint committees with the advice of fellow Board members;
- 4. to act as an ex-officio member of all committees;
- 5. to execute all documents on behalf of the Board:
- 6. to perform the usual and ordinary duties of the office.

## Duties of the Vice-President

The Vice-President shall be authorized to act for the President in case of the President's absence or inability to act, within statutory limitations.

## Duties of the Clerk

The Clerk shall be authorized to act for the President in case of the President's and Vice President's absence or inability to act, within statutory limitations.
