

INTERSCHOLASTIC ATHLETICS REGULATION

All interscholastic athletic teams shall participate in the Mountain Valley Athletic Conference.

Athletic Training and Sportsmanship

1. Players shall not smoke, use alcohol or illegal drugs. Violation of this rule as reported by any teacher or coach will result in suspension from the team for the remainder of the interscholastic athletic season.
2. Players may not participate in a new interscholastic athletic season until the current season is over. Players will not be penalized for missing early season practice.
3. Players must ride the school bus to games and return on the bus unless the parent or guardian checks with the coach at the game. First violation will result in suspension for one game and the second violation will result in suspension for the remainder of the season.
4. Displays of poor sportsmanship, obscene gestures or language, fights (as an aggressor) shall result in either a warning, suspension from one or more games or suspension for the remainder of the season, depending upon the severity of the incident.
5. Players must be on time for practice and attend each practice. Penalties are at the discretion of the coach. Players must be in school the day of the game unless excused by the Building Principal. Otherwise, he/she will not be able to participate that day.
6. Coaches may impose additional training rules and require certain dress for games. These and their penalties are at the discretion of the coach and must be given in writing to the participants.
7. Two failing grades or two failing deficiencies at the end of five (5) weeks means ineligibility for five (5) weeks. Reinstatement is at the discretion of the coach. Players will be removed or reinstated on the Tuesday after the five or ten week period.

Post Season Eligibility

Any player eligible to play during the regular season shall be eligible to play in any sectional or state competition.
