## **ENERGY MANAGEMENT**

The Board of Education will direct the Superintendent of Schools to develop and implement both immediate and long-range plans designed to conserve district energy resources. Such plans will include the designation of an individual to oversee energy consumption levels of all facilities, including transportation.

The person overseeing energy usage will also make recommendations for operations and maintenance procedures, as well as any capital expenditures necessary to achieve maximum cost-efficiency of all district energy use. He/She will work with the Superintendent to develop contingency plans in the event of an energy shortage.

The Board may apply for any applicable grants to initiate and/or sustain its energy conservation program. Progress reports on the implementation of energy conservation measures will be made to the Board on an annual basis.
