

INTERSCHOLASTIC ATHLETICS REGULATION

All interscholastic athletic teams shall participate in the Mountain Valley Athletic Conference.

Athletic Training and Sportsmanship

1. Students participating in extracurricular activities shall not possess, use, be under the influence of, or distribute tobacco products, nicotine products, electronic smoking devices, alcohol, cannabis, controlled substances, or any other substance that is prohibited by law or district policy, including products that are unlawful for the student's age. Violations of this provision shall be addressed in accordance with the District's Code of Conduct, as adopted and amended by the Board of Education.
2. Players may not participate in a new interscholastic athletic season until the current season is over. Players will not be penalized for missing early season practice.
3. Student-athletes shall travel to and from athletic contests on district- provided transportation. A student may be released only to their parent or legal guardian after the parent or guardian has checked in with the coach and district release procedures have been followed. Failure to comply with these transportation requirements may result in disciplinary action by the Athletic Director and/or building administration in accordance with district policy and the Extracurricular Code of Conduct.
4. Displays of poor sportsmanship, obscene gestures or language, fights (as an aggressor) shall result in either a warning, suspension from one or more games or suspension for the remainder of the season, depending upon the severity of the incident.
5. Players must be on time for practice and attend each practice. Penalties are at the discretion of the coach. Players must be in school that day and arrive before the time indicated in the code of conduct to be eligible to play in a game or participate in practice that day.
6. Coaches may impose additional training rules and require certain dress for games. These and their penalties are at the discretion of the coach and must be given in writing to the participants.
7. Academic eligibility for participation in extracurricular activities shall be governed by the District's Code of Conduct. Students who are determined to be academically ineligible shall be required to meet all applicable conditions for continued participation or reinstatement as outlined in the Code of Conduct.

Post Season Eligibility

Any player eligible to play during the regular season shall be eligible to play in any sectional or state competition.

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
